# EGGS AND BACON!

Beloved,

So we have entered Lent – *(Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return. Turn away from sin and be faithful to Christ.)* 

We have 40 days (that's if we don't count the Sundays – so it's actually 46!) to fast and pray.

You may have given something up, you may have taken something on?

I hope to see you all at some of the extra worship across this Holy Season:

*Stations of the cross* – a meditative service, walking and praying the way of the Cross.

*Rosary* – a quiet period of meditative prayer which uses beads to touch and repetition to pray alongside Mary so you can concentrate your mind, on the mind of Christ.

*Lent Course* – come and explore the Bible and discover something of the women in it.

You may wish to come and see me for some spiritual direction or even *Confession*?

The Sacrament of *Reconciliation* can be both a formal service or a more informal conversation.

It is not about being embarrassed with your Vicar, but a chance to meet Christ and taste a glimpse of heaven! My advice would be – ALL May, NONE Must, SOME Should. Of course Lent is a very solemn and penitential season and has that feeling to it,

a time for self-examination and study, but in the middle of our Lenten journey we have a little relief from the Rigour of it – Mothering Sunday and then the great and often overlooked feast of the Annunciation (there will be a Eucharist at 12noon in St Mark's).

A reminder of that young girl, called to be the mother of God's Son, terrified by an angel took God's message and said 'Yes' and changed the world, changing our lives forever.

When it comes to the church building and the liturgy we use, you will notice a few differences – we start to see purple, we are bare of flowers and decoration, items disappear, statues and crosses are covered, banners are turned around, we stop singing the Gloria and we don't say the A-Word! So when I talk about 'Eggs-and-Bacon', I'm not making a reference to breakfast collections for Open Door, but speaking of Heaven's song that we have buried and we shall sing of again at Eastertide.

Thankyou for the generous donations towards my Lent appeal that have already come in, and if you get bored of buying chicken's eggs and prefer to buy chocolate

mini ones, then don't forget they are the Vicar's favourite!

For thus said the Lord God, the Holy One of Israel: In returning and rest you shall be saved; in quietness and in trust shall be your strength. (Isaiah 30.15)

May you have a Holy Lent, (Don't get to Easter, without having 'lived' Lent!)
