







The Merry Month of May!

God has gone up with a shout, the Lord with the sound of a trumpet. (Psalm 47:5)

Beloved,

ALLELUIA! Christ is Risen! We continue through the Great Fifty Days of Eastertide.

I do love the month of May and because of the way Easter has fallen this year, it is full of even more greater festivals.

May is traditionally Mary's month in particular as we finish on the last day with her visit to dear Elizabeth and the baby, John the Baptiser leaps in the womb, as Mary falls into song, as old and new are brought together.

We begin the month of May with 'Pip and Jim'. The Apostles Philip and James the Less (so Son of Alphaeus, Not Son of Zebedee or Brother of John). They are perhaps minor of the 12, as we have little about their lives. But the Gospels hint that James' mother was a witness to the crucifixion and he went on to lead the early church. Philip is very prominent especially in John's Gospel - he is a great spokesman - he gets involved at the feeding miracle, he brings along Nathanael, he asks questions of the Last Supper and about heaven - I think I rather like my middle name! Later on the 14th we celebrate Matthias — the one who was chosen, as well as a scattering on Minor Saints: Augustine, Bede, Dunstan, the Wesley's, Calvin and even Julian of Norwich — all shall be well and all shall be well and all manner of things shall be well.

On the 40th Day of Easter – Ascension Day, we shall have a Eucharist at 7pm in St Mark's Church, as we recall the Lord taking up his throne in heaven (9th).

Then we have 10 days to wait expectantly for the coming of the promised Holy Spirit when the Church will be set on fire upon the day of Pentecost (19th).

We also have Trinity Sunday on the 26th to ponder the great mysteries.

May you know the blessings of the Risen and Ascended Christ, this Eastertide, and may you be set on fire with the Holy Spirit as we celebrate the Church's Birthday and may the myriad of Saints pray for you all – Have a Merry May!
